Day 3	Phu Quoc Island Tour Morning enjoy Hon Thom Cable Car (world's longest sea-crossing cable car). Relax at the beach, try snorkeling & water sports. Evening visit Dinh Cau Night Market. Dinner and overnight stay at Phu Quoc.
Day 4	Danang Breakfast at hotel. Transfer to airport for flight to Danang. Arrival and hotel check-in. Evening enjoy My Khe Beach walk. Overnight stay at Danang.
Day 5	Bana Hills Morning drive to Bana Hills. Cable car ride, visit Golden Bridge, French Village, Fantasy Park. Afternoon proceed to Hoi An Ancient Town – visit Japanese Bridge, Lantern Market & Thu Bon River. Return to Danang for overnight stay.
Day 6	Danang City Tour Breakfast at hotel. Visit Marble Mountains, Dragon Bridge, Han Market, and Lady Buddha Pagoda at Son Tra Peninsula. Evening free at My Khe Beach. Dinner and overnight stay at Danang.
Day 7	Ho Chi Minh After breakfast, transfer to airport for flight to Ho Chi Minh. Visit Notre Dame Cathedral, Central Post Office, War Remnants Museum, and Ben Thanh Market. Evening enjoy a Saigon River Cruise with dinner. Overnight stay in Ho Chi Minh.
Day 8	After breakfast, transfer to airport for return flight to Delhi with wonderful memories of Vietnam.

Rules and Facilities for Traveling Abroad to Vietnam



Tour Cost & Payment Information: The total cost of the Vietnam tour is ₹89,000/- per person. This includes return flight tickets from Delhi to Vietnam, 3 domestic flights between cities, A/C double bed hotel rooms, breakfast, lunch, dinner, tea, transport and sightseeing. To confirm the booking, an advance amount of ₹25,000/- per person must be deposited at the time of registration. The remaining balance has to be paid at least ten days before the start of the tour. If any traveler cancels the journey after booking, the advance amount will not be refunded.

Meals & Stay: During the tour, breakfast, lunch, evening tea or coffee, and dinner will be served daily. Meals will be arranged in hotels or local restaurants depending on availability. Accommodation will be provided in double bed sharing rooms. If any traveler wishes to stay in a single room, an extra charge of ₹12,000/- will apply. Hotel check-in and checkout will follow the local rules and timings of each destination.

Air Travel & Baggage Rules: For air travel, each traveler is allowed to carry up to 25 kg of check-in baggage and 7 kg of hand baggage. Any excess weight will be charged directly by the airline. Travelers must handle their own baggage during airport transfers.

Travel Documents: For this journey, a valid passport is mandatory. The passport should have a minimum of six months validity from the date of travel. Travelers must carry their original passport along with copies of their visa and e-tickets at all times. Without valid documents, boarding will not be permitted and the tour cost will be non-refundable.

Local Transport: Transport within Vietnam will be arranged through air-conditioned buses/mini coaches or vans depending on the group size. In some cities, smaller vehicles may be used due to local traffic rules and narrow streets.

Special Instructions: Entry fees of attractions, boating charges, optional rides such as water sports, cable cars, adventure activities, traditional show, bana hills tickets or any personal shopping expenses will not be included in the package. The tour manager will guide the group at every step, but each traveler will be responsible for their own belongings and safety.

Safety & Health: The travel company will not be responsible for any personal illness, accident, or loss of valuable items during the journey. In case of medical emergencies, arrangements can be made for hospital or doctor visits, but the expenses must be borne by the traveler. Senior citizens and those with health issues are advised to take extra care, and they may use local taxis or transport if required at their own cost.

Important Note: Sometimes weather conditions, flight delays, traffic problems, or local government restrictions may cause changes in the sightseeing program. In such cases, travelers are requested to cooperate with the tour manager and follow instructions for smooth and safe travel.
